Directions: Take your best route to Grandview, Iowa where US 61 meets IA 92, approximately 15 miles south of Muscatine, Iowa. Take County Rd G48 (Jackson St.) east through Grandview, jog south on Jefferson St. for a block and continue immediately east again on 148th St (Cemetery Ln). After about 2 miles, 148th street curves to the south and becomes Avenue H. The road into the site will be on your right. Watch for the large white SCA signs by the roadside
